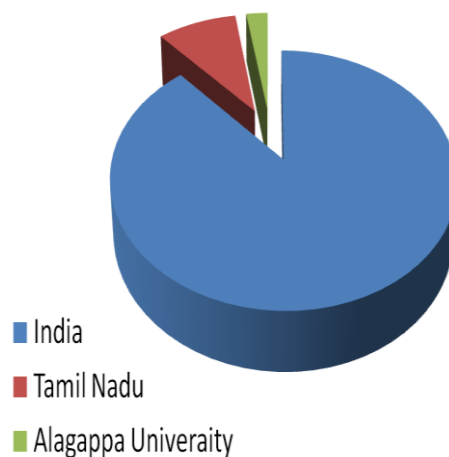

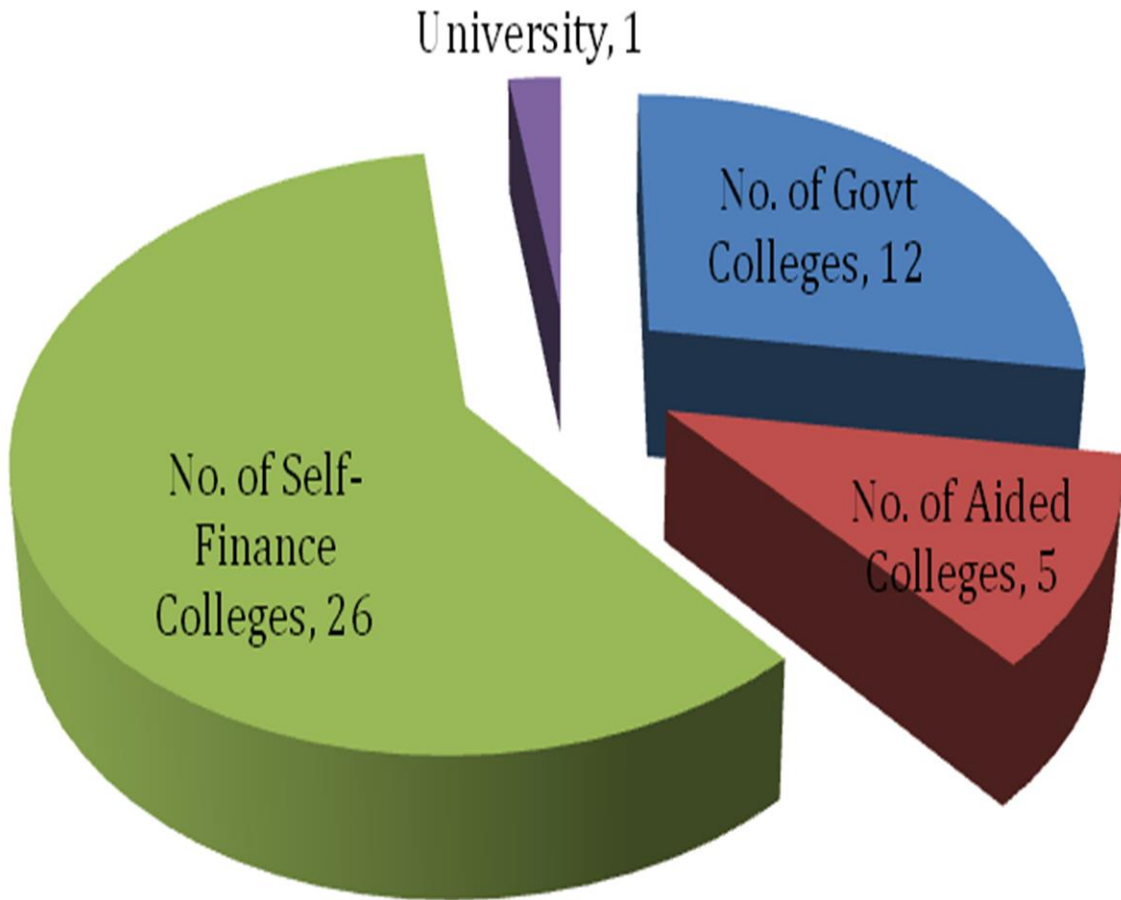
## NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME OF ALAGAPPA UNIVERSITY

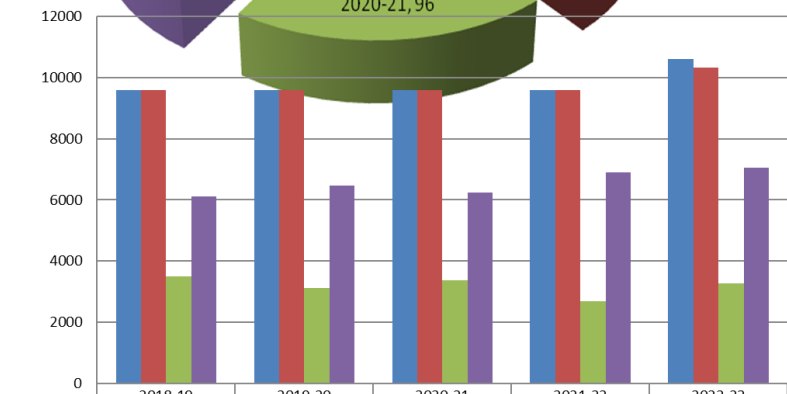
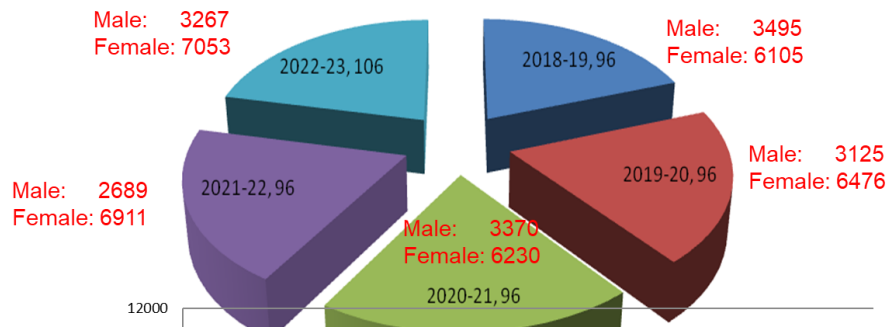
NSS Volunteer Strength

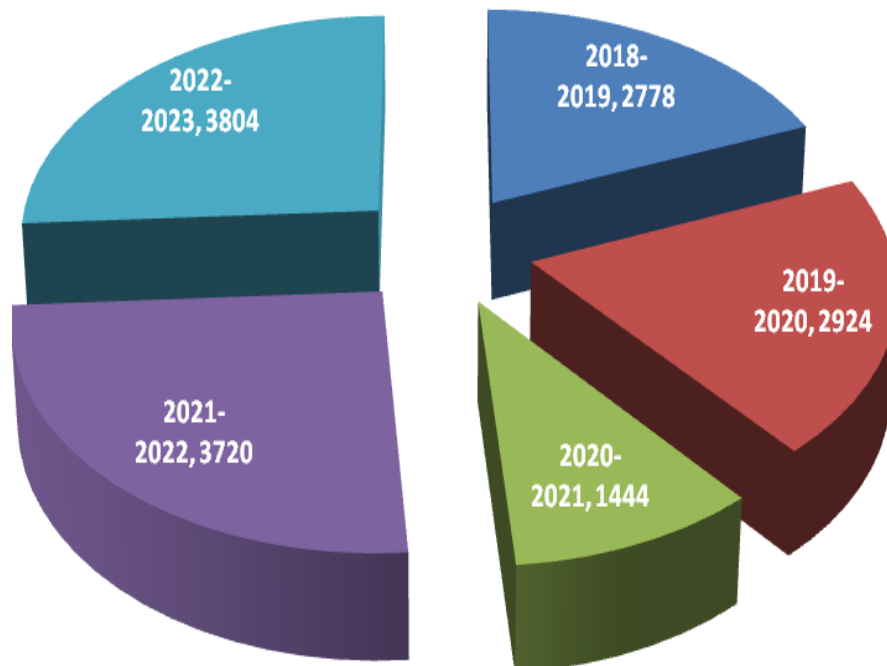

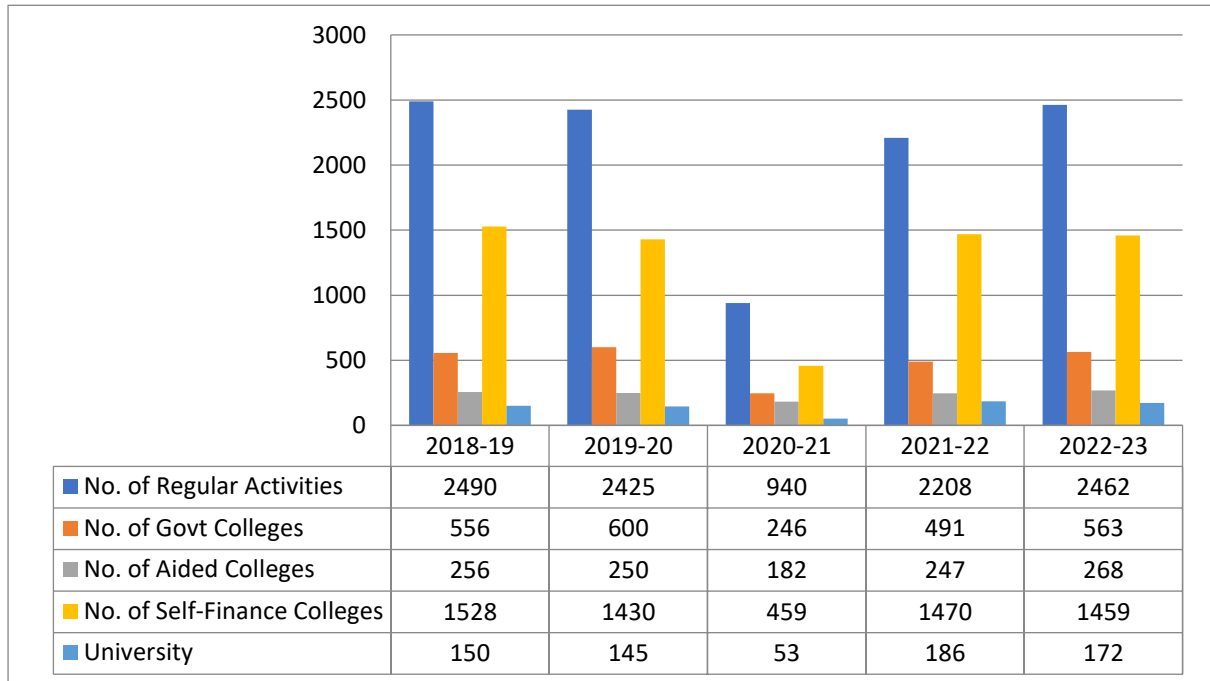

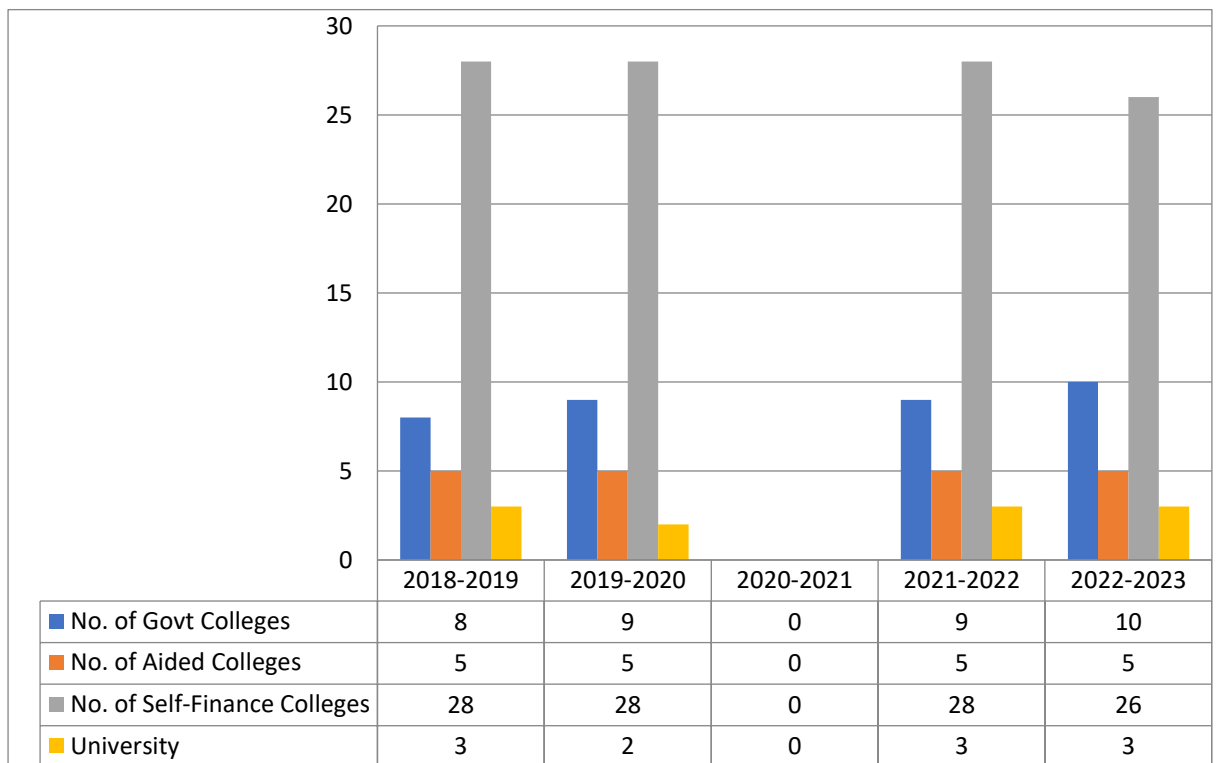


## NSS Regular Activity / Awareness Programmes 2018-2019 – 2022-2023

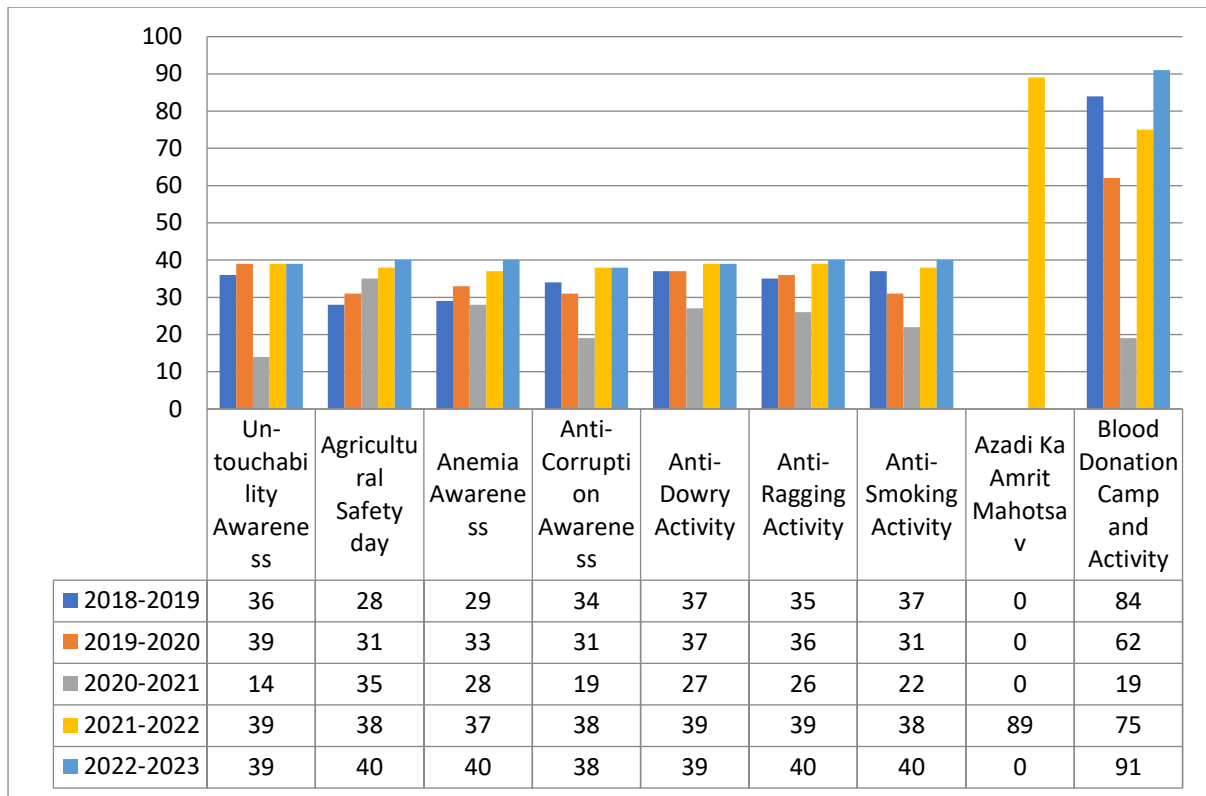
